8:45 am – 6:15 pm	Activity: Shelburne Museum , spend all day at this museum. https://shelburnemuseum.org/ The Shelburne Museum is a museum of art, design, and Americana located in Shelburne, VT. Over 150,000 works are exhibited in 38 exhibition buildings, 25 of which are historic and were relocated to the museum grounds. It is located on 45 acres near Lake Champlain. This is a unique museum where you will definitely find something of interest. The museum closes at 5:00 pm. No Campfire scheduled for tonight.

8:30 am – 10:30 am	Activity: Quechee Gorge , the deepest gorge in Vermont. www.vtstateparks.com/htm/quechee.htm Easy hike across the gorge bridge. Optional moderate hike to the base of the gorge and the Ottauquchee River. Other area activities: Quechee Gorge Visitors Center and shopping.	
10:30 am – 12:30 pm	Activity: Sugarbush Farm https://sugarbushfarm.com/ This three-generation family farm is famous for its excellent waxed cheeses and pure maple syrup made right on the farm. See the work room where they hand wrap and hand wax the cheese You'll find free samples of cheese, 4 grades of maple syrup and the farm store is full of jams, mustard's, spreads and meats made locally.

3:00 pm – 4:00 pm	Activity: Brookfield Floating Bridge https://brookfieldhistoricalsociety.wordpress.com/brookfield-history/floating-bridge/ The floating bridge carries Vermont Route 65 across Sunset Lake. It is the only floating bridge east of the Mississippi River.
