The 2020 rate is \$50.00 per night for waterfront sites and \$46.00 per night for waterview sites. The sites include water, electric, and sewer hookups. The campground has blocked out 12 sites in Area 3 for our group. Some members of the group will arrive on Thursday and stay until Monday. If you wish to extend your fun, you are welcome to join us.

Make your reservation by calling Terrace Pines directly. **The deadline is March 31, 2021.** Be sure to tell them you are with the Trailblazers rally hosted by Rick Newcomb. Because these are prime sites for the campground, we have a deadline that is earlier than usual.

The potluck and other activities for the weekend will be determined closer to the rally, based on the status of COVID-19 at that time and any required restrictions. The weekend activities schedule will be sent via the chapter's group email list. Important Driving Directions and Info: If you are using a GPS, after Ossipee Center, when you turn from Moultonville Road to Valley Road, your GPS may say "in 2.x miles navigate off road." This is OK because the "off road" is the campground road. Also, Valley Road changes from a paved to a dirt road after approx. 1.5 miles.

At the campground entrance, there are two roads. You will want to turn on the road to the left. You will see a Tennis/Basketball court on the left road. The office is a short distance on your right. Your GPS may try to send you up the road to right but do NOT follow the GPS directions. The road to the right is a DEAD END.
